The Senior Scholarship:

The SDNC-CAPMT annual scholarship is for graduating seniors who want to continue their musical education beyond high school. The award is to encourage and give financial aid to students planning to further their musical education.

Requirements and Rules

1. Eligibility:

The scholarship is open to instrumental and vocal high school senior students. The applicant must be recommended by his or her teacher who must be an active member of SD-CAPMT District 1 of the California Association of Professional Music Teachers. Applicant must be a current student of a CAPMT member for at least 6 months. In the case that the teacher or the student has recently moved into the area, their special circumstances will be considered by the scholarship committee.

2. Award:

The total award offered this year is \$500. The scholarship chair, along with the board and scholarship committee will decide on the amount of money distributed to the winner(s).

3. Evaluation:

The evaluation will be based on three sections

- a. Audition- 70%
- b. Participation in MTNA and CAPMT events – 20%
- c. The musical accomplishments and contributions to the community- 10%
Such as but not limited to participation in choir, orchestra, band, ensembles or accompanying within school or church.

4. Audition:

The audition will take place in the form of a closed recital

- a. Instrumental students must perform three compositions from at least two different periods of music history and in contrasting styles. Vocal students should also perform with at least three contrasting selections, one of which should be in a foreign language.
- b. Music selected must be an original composition with no arrangements.
- c. Length of playing time is approximately 15 to 20 minutes. Students will be stopped if program exceeds time limit.

- d. Vocal music and solo Piano Music must be memorized. Other instrumentalists may use the music.
- e. Participant must provide original music scores with measure numbers for the adjudicator.
- f. Judging will be on technique, interpretation, selection of repertoire, and memorization.

5. Application Procedure:

- a. Download the application form, complete and submit it with the application fee. Please mail to Tavner Delcamp: 10948 Creekbridge Dr., San Diego, CA 92128. - b. The application form and fee must be postmarked no later than May 25, 2019.

6. Application Fee:

The application fee is \$45.00 per student. The teachers are responsible for collecting payment from their own students and write the check or money order to **SDNC-CAPMT**. Only one check per teacher if a teacher is sending more than one student. Please put "Senior Scholarships" on the memo line. Personal checks from students will not be accepted. This fee is non-refundable and should be mailed together with the application form.

7. In the event of extenuating circumstances, the Scholarship Committee has the final ruling on the Scholarship decisions.
